

Bob Evans Farms Inc. owns and operates full-service, family restaurants in 21 states. Bob Evans Restaurants are primarily located in the East North Central, mid-Atlantic and Southern United States, while Owens Restaurants operate in Texas. The company is also a leading producer of pork sausage and other convenience food items under the Bob Evans and Owens brand names.

In 2003, the company sales continued to total more than \$1 billion. Of these sales, 83 percent was generated from restaurants and the remaining 17 percent from food products. The Bob Evans Farms Nasdaq trading symbol is BOBE.

- Owens Country Sausage, a subsidiary of Bob Evans Farms, is a regional food products company based in Richardson, Texas; acquired on Jan. 16, 1987.
- The company's first distribution center opened in September 2002 in Springfield, Ohio.

HISTORY

- In 1948, company-founder Bob Evans made sausage at his southeastern Ohio farm for the 12-stool, 24-hour restaurant he owned in Gallipolis, Ohio.
- In 1953, a group of Bob Evans' friends and family recognized the growing demand for his sausage, became business partners and founded the company.
- Bob Evans Farms became a publicly held company June 6, 1963. Reincorporated in Delaware in 1985, the company's headquarters is located in Columbus, Ohio.
- Company founder Bob Evans retired from the company in 1986 and currently lives on his farm in Gallia County, Ohio. Bob is very active in the community through his support of 4-H and FFA youth programs, wildlife preservation and programs to benefit family farms.

- The nearly 1,000-acre Bob Evans Farm, in Rio Grande, Ohio, is a tourist destination featuring the first Bob Evans Restaurant; the Homestead Museum, a home on the National Register of Historic Places where Bob and his wife, Jewell, raised their six children; a log cabin village; and several special events throughout the year including the October Bob Evans Farm Festival.
